

# 5-CHROM-03

Chromogenic Substrate for Plasmin and Plasminogen-SK

## Description:

A chromogenic substrate for the amidolytic assay of Plasmin or Plasminogen-SK.

Formula: pyro-Glu-Phe-Lys-pNA.HCl (C<sub>26</sub>H<sub>32</sub>N<sub>6</sub>O<sub>6</sub>.HCl)

Molecular weight: 524.6 D

Composition: Enzymatically digestible substrate

K<sub>M</sub>: 0.29 mmol/L (Plasmin)

k<sub>cat</sub>: 92<sup>S-1</sup> (Plasmin)

Purity, via RP-HPLC: ≥ 95%

Solubility: Up to 25 mg/mL in water

## Assay Conditions:

Enzyme activity is determined by measuring the increase in absorbance of the free chromophore (pNA) generated per unit time at a wavelength of 405 nm. At excess substrate concentrations, the rate at which the absorbance increases due to the amount of chromophore released is linearly related to enzyme concentration. Measurement can be made either through acid quenching of the reaction (end-point method), or through use of a kinetic recording spectrophotometer (initial-rate-method).

## Presentation:

Ref. 5D-30802 glass vial containing 25 mg (~48 µmoles) of lyophilized, digestible substrate.

## Storage and Stability:

Lyophilized substrate may be stored in the dark at 2°-8°C up to the expiration date stated on the vial. Protect from moisture by allowing vial to reach room temperature prior to opening.

Reconstituted substrate may be stored for 1 week at room temperature or 2 months at 2°-8°C. Do not freeze.
